

Benzie Central High School Athletics Rules Quick Look up 2009 – 2010

1. **Attendance** – must be enrolled before competing in game or scrimmage: must be in school all day to practice or participate in athletic events
2. **Age** – cannot be over 19 on or before August 31, 2009
3. **Grades** – must have passed 66% of a full time class load during previous semester
4. **Physical Examinations** – must be current (since April 15, 2009) and in the athletic office
5. **Code of Conduct** – behavior becoming a HUSKY athlete – no law enforcement contact, no use or possession of alcohol, drugs, look-a-likes, performance enhancing, no involvement thefts, destruction of property or other poor choices.
6. **Academic Expectations** – must be passing all classes each Friday when grades are checked – First “F” will be one week of probation any more will be sitting out for at least the Monday to Sunday following the Friday grade check. Failures on report cards cause for sitting out 1st week of next marking period.
7. **Debts** – all debts must be cleared before playing in an athletic event.
8. **Physical Education** – if you are enrolled in physical education and are too ill to participate then you are too ill to participate in your athletic commitments on the same day.
9. **Transportation** – school transportation will be provided to athletic events and may be provided home for events; otherwise your parent may sign you out to ride home with them or you may have a note signed by an administrator to ride home with someone else as long as you are signed out with the coach; or you will be directed to ride home with other designated drivers.
10. **Parent Conferences** – if as a parent you want to have a conversation with a coach of your child – please make sure your child is aware of your concern and then make an appointment with a coach – don’t take offense that they will not speak to you during practice, before or immediately after a contest – give them some space as these are times they are expected to be with your child and the other athletes on the team. Contact for a meeting – they will be happy to meet with you and your athlete about any concerns other than playing time – your child knows what they need to do to get more playing time.
11. **Medical Care** – if you go to the Doctor make sure you get a release to return to play.
